

Creating a Cascading Style Sheet

1. Create a new Web site using the One Page Web Site Template. In the Site Templates dialog box, click One Page Web Site and then select where to save the files. Click the Okay button
2. Double click the Index.htm in the file list to edit this file
3. Create a page that looks like the page below. Be sure and use the style that each line of text describes.

This is Heading 1 style

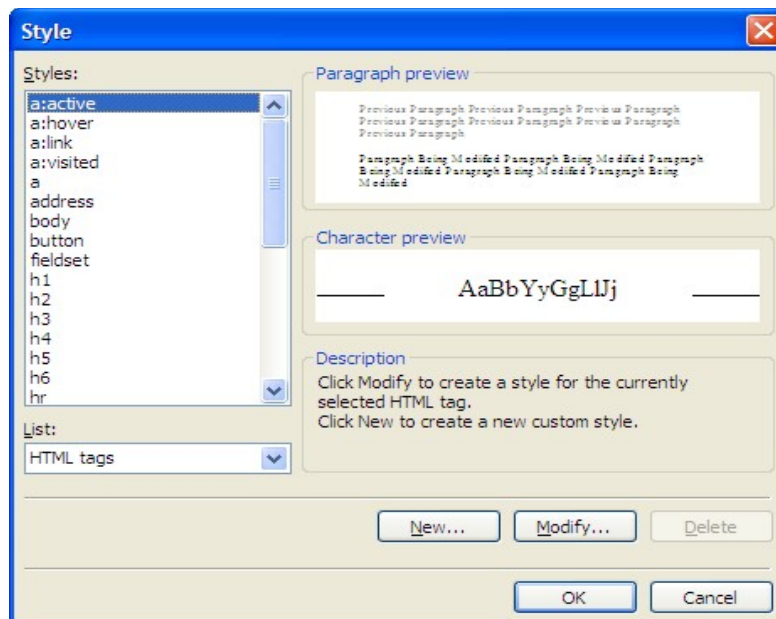
This is Heading 2 style

This is Heading 3 style

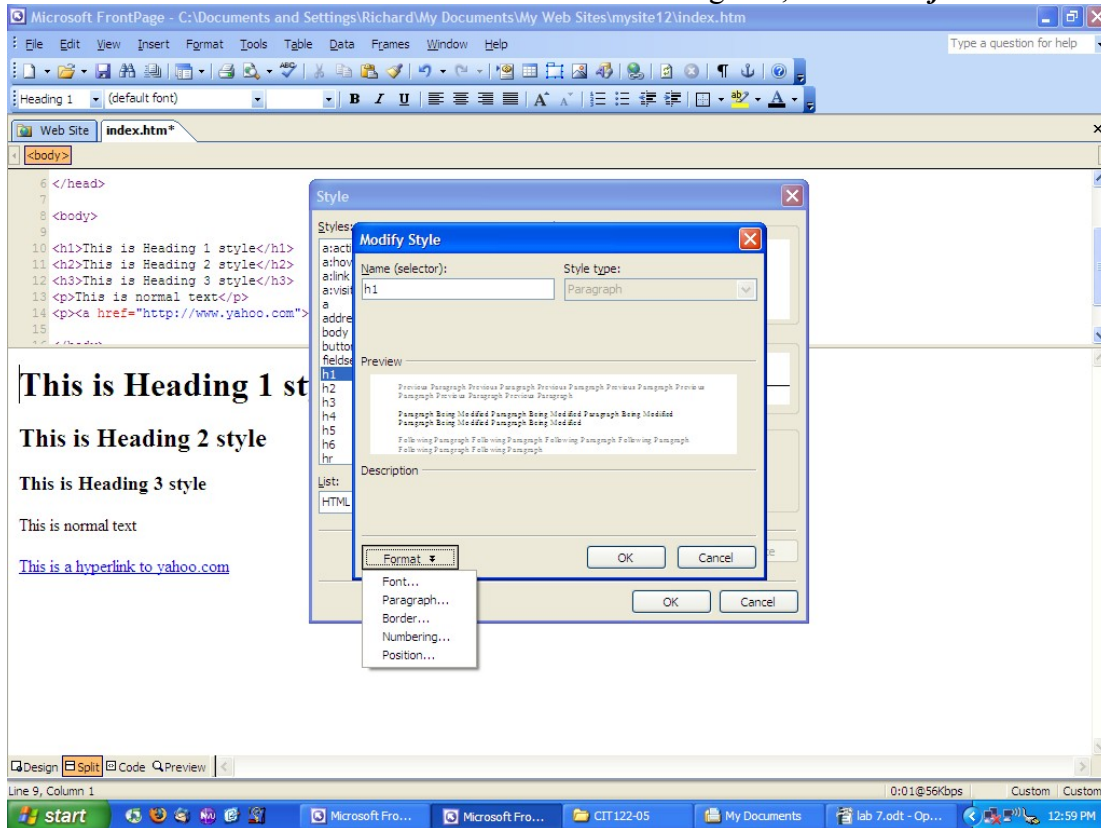
This is normal text

4. Create a new style for the Heading 1 style. Click the Format Menu and Select Style. A dialog box that look like the one below will open.



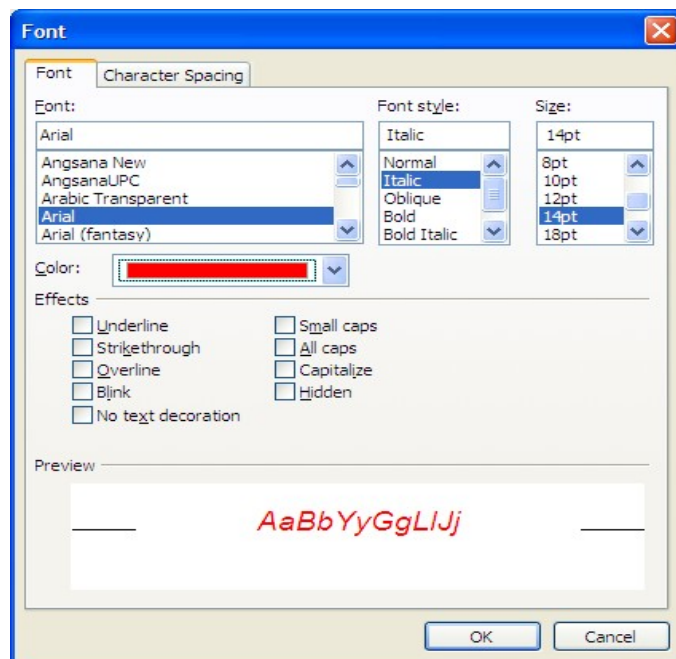
5. Select H1 (heading 1) from the styles list and click the **Modify** Button.
6. Click the **format** button at the bottom of the dialog box, and select **font**.



7. Change the font to Arial, Italic, and 14 point, as shown on the right.
8. Press the OK button and all three dialog boxes.
9. **Follow steps 4-8 above to change:**

H2: *Arial*
12 point
blue

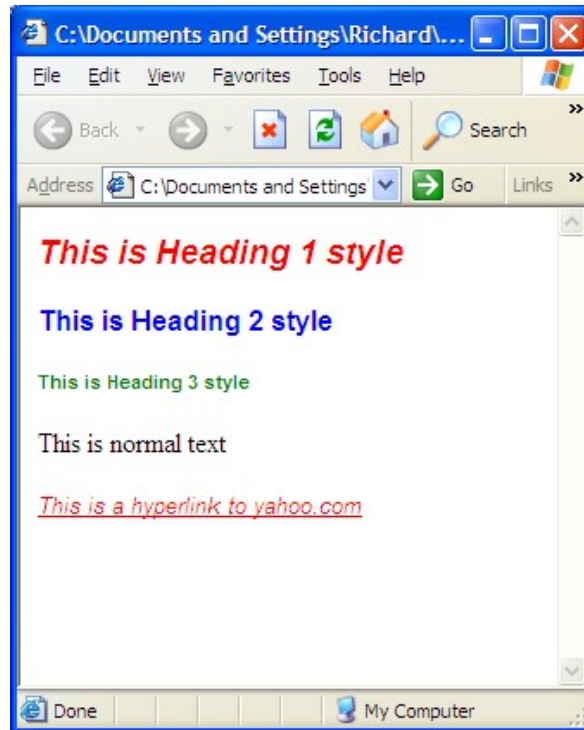
H3: *Arial*
8 point
green



*A:link:Arial
8 point
red*

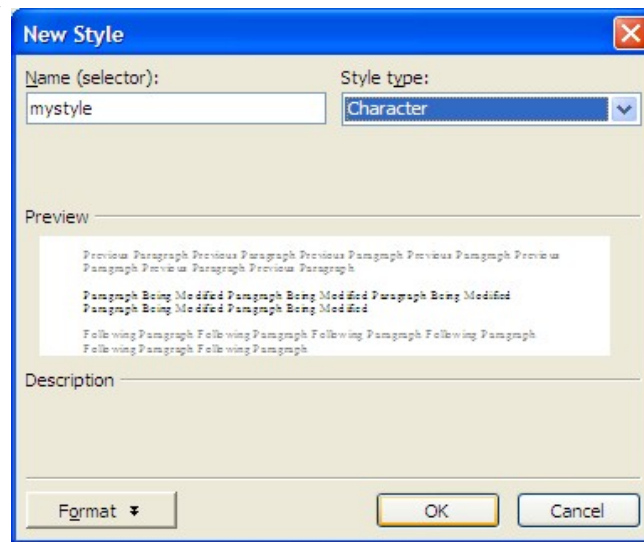
*A:hover:Arial
8 point
black*

10. Your web page should look like:

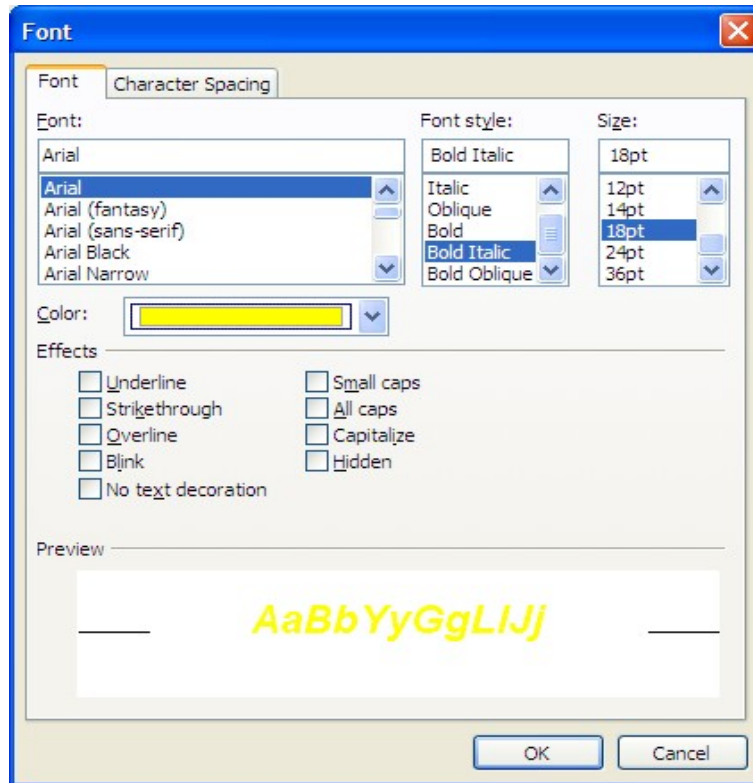


11. Now we want to create a new style. Open the Style Dialog box again, and click the **New** button.

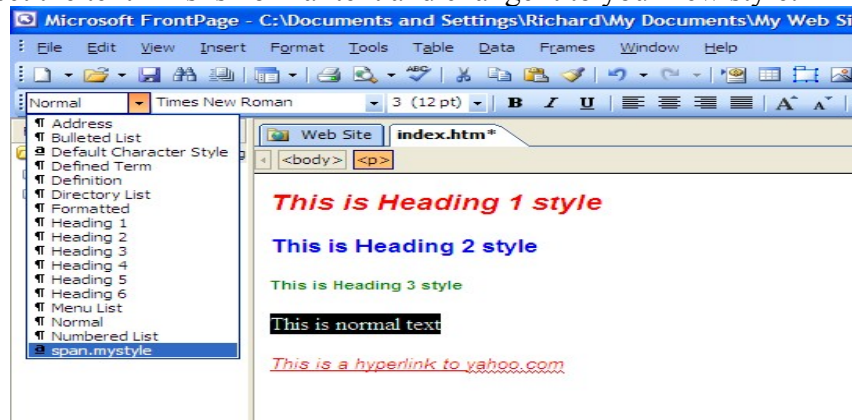
12. Type mystyle for the name and Character for the type. See Dialog box to the right
